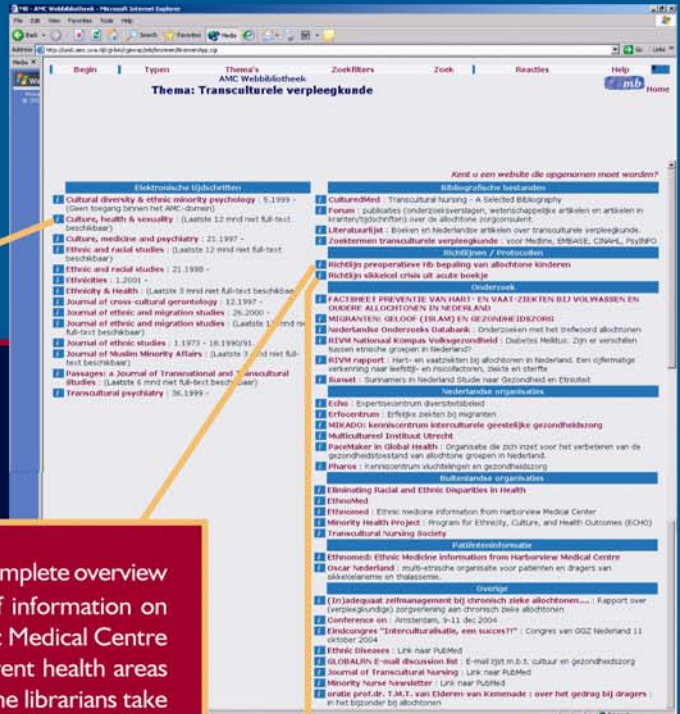


# Selected electronic resources on ethnic diversity and nursing in the AMC web library.

As the Academic Medical Centre(AMC) in Amsterdam strongly supports evidence-based medicine, doctors and nurses need to have easy access to medical information. They want to know the best available evidence to support their practice and their decision making. The medical library tries to present its information as user-friendly as possible, so not only doctors and nurses, but also researchers, managers and patients can easily find the information they need.

The web library was developed in 2003, as an interface to search the electronic information by specialty and by subspecialty. AMC employees can do this on their own personal computer, in their own workplace. They don't need to come to the library.

The librarians also developed themes, for example *ethnic diversity and nursing*.

By searching on this theme, nurses get the following information

- Links to electronic journals on this subject, to which the AMC has full access
- Links to PubMed journals on ethnic diversity
- Links to AMC guidelines on nursing of migrant patients, or on diseases which often occur in migrant patients, like sickle cell anemia
- Links to relevant and interesting websites of national and international organisations
- Search terms to search Medline, Embase, PsycInfo and CINAHL for articles on ethnic diversity.
- A bibliography of Dutch articles on ethnic diversity and nursing

The librarians work together with experts in the field of the nursing of ethnic diverse patients, to keep this theme uptodate.
